In addition, Milford students must pass Ohio Graduation Tests, complete the Career Passport, and have 20 hours of community serv						
In addition, in Loveland, 2 majors and 2 minors are required. All must pass the Ohio Graduation Tests and have 8 terms of attenda						
Ohio's Home School notification subject area requirements:
